Microsoft has also focused on rebuilding the community sharing experiences with a more immersive Activity Feed, and the Game Bar is improved in Windows 10 with a single button that allows you to enable or disable Game Mode (which optimizes system resources for game

performance) and there are new more detailed settings for sharing audio when broadcasting via Mixer.

Microsoft sure seems to do a lot of rethinking with the Xbox interface, and it can be a jolt to players since once they're used to one redesign, a new one seems to immediately take its place. As mentioned, these are rolling out for Insiders only for now, and will make their way to general users later this year alongside other major Xbox and Windows 10 updates.
